### CERTIFICATION PROGRAM OUTLINE

**Upon acceptance into the program, the CPS Certification Program requires:**

- Participation via web in 14 or 16-weekly group supervision sessions (# of sessions is dependent on size of group)
- Individualized, written feedback on at least 3 recordings of you having Plan B conversations
- Attend at least two 1:1 Live Coaching Calls
- Feedback on written responses to commonly asked questions

**After successfully completing these steps, participants are officially CPS Certified!**
